MECC, King University Sign Reverse Transfer Agreement

TriCities.Com | March 30, 2015 | "Students who have completed a minimum of 15 semester hours toward their associate degree at MECC and a set number of semester hours at King University may be eligible for the reverse transfer program, according to a written statement."

DSCC and TSU Sign Dual Admission/Reverse Transfer Agreement

State Gazette | March 28, 2015 | "Dyersburg State Community College and Tennessee State University met on Thursday, March 26 to sign a Dual Admission/Reverse Transfer Agreement. This partnership establishes an articulation agreement between the two institutions and formalizes the process for DSCC students that wish to transfer to TSU."

NIU, Elgin Community College Ink Reverse Transfer Agreement

NIU Today | March 10, 2015 | "Northern Illinois University President Doug Baker and Elgin Community CollegePresident David Sam signed an innovative reverse transfer agreement during a Tuesday afternoon ceremony in Elgin. The agreement allows eligible NIU students who transferred from ECC without associate degrees to earn the two-year degree using credit from NIU courses."

California University of Pennsylvania and Westmoreland County Community College sign Reverse Transfer Agreement.

WCC.edu | March 6, 2015 | "California University of Pennsylvania and Westmoreland County Community College today signed an agreement that will allow students enrolled at Cal U to complete the diploma or associate degree they began at WCCC."

Troy University and Jefferson Davis Community College sign Reverse Transfer Agreement Trojan News Center | March 5, 2015 | "Troy University and Jefferson Davis Community College officials signed an agreement that would enable transfer students to complete their associate's degree while pursuing their bachelor's degree. The Reverse Transfer agreement permits former Jefferson Davis Community College students who transfer to Troy University to transfer eligible credits back to JDCC for the purpose of attaining an associate degree."


ISU and Ivy Tech Community College Announce New Reverse Transfer Program
