The equity-centered comprehensive local-needs assessment, developed by OCCRL, has six guiding objectives: progress toward implementing CTE programs of study; student performance data; recruitment, retention and training of CTE faculty/staff; labor market alignment; size, scope and quality as defined by the state of Illinois plan for Perkins V; and progress toward improving access and equity.
