Call for Presentations - Due Friday

Presentation proposals are due Friday, December 20, 2013 for the <u>Scaling Up Pathways to Results</u> <u>2014</u> conference.

Who should apply?

Representatives from P-20 educational institutions are encouraged to submit breakout session presentation proposals for the conference. Preference will be given to proposals that provide new information in areas such as partnerships, data use, process improvement, equity and outcomes improvement, career pathways, and curriculum alignment.

Why should practitioners apply?

Practitioners experiences provide important insight into the implementation and application of the PTR process and as such are highly valued by the planning committee. Presenters can anticipate feedback from conference participants, and will have the opportunity to build partnerships among practitioners with similar goals.

What is required?

This proposal is brief: a 200 word summary and information about your knowledge on the subject matter. Partner presentations are welcome. Presentations will be 20-30 minutes long, as assigned by the conference committee.

What is the next step?
