Different than in years past, teams' PTR work will be concentrated through participation in an intensive two-day institute to prepare for the final deliverable an intervention plan that is eligible to be considered for a Year Two PTR grant to support implementation and scaling of the project intervention in the 2016/2017 academic year.

Teams will be selected based on their commitment to engage in a PTR project in one of five focus areas:

- * Adult Career Pathways
- * Improvement of Federal Perkins Measures
- * Retention or Completion Improvement Across Multiple Programs
- * Transfer Pathways
- * Program Review
- * Secondary to Postsecondary Transitions
