Project Profile: National Information, Security, and Geospatial Technology Consortium (NISGTC) Evaluation

Overview

The National Information, Security, and Geospatial Technology Consortium (NISGTC) is funded by the United States Department of Labor's Trade Adjustment Assistance Community College and Career Training (TAACCCT) grant. The NISGTC consortium includes community colleges, partner employers, workforce and community based organizations who seek to improve Information Technology (IT) professions education and training that leads to credential attainment. The Office of Community College Research and Leadership (OCCRL) is implementing the external evaluation for the NISGTC Consortium, including conducting an implementation study, supporting quarterly and annual reporting, and conducting a quasi-experimental study.

Goals

- Assess the implementation of NISGTC Consortium's core strategies.
- Support accurate and timely analysis and delivery of the quarterly and annual performance reports.
- Conduct a quasi-experimental evaluation, including assessing outcomes for NISGTC participants and comparison student cohorts.

- Impact studies assessing the effects of TAACCCT-funded POS and core strategies on NISGTC participants
