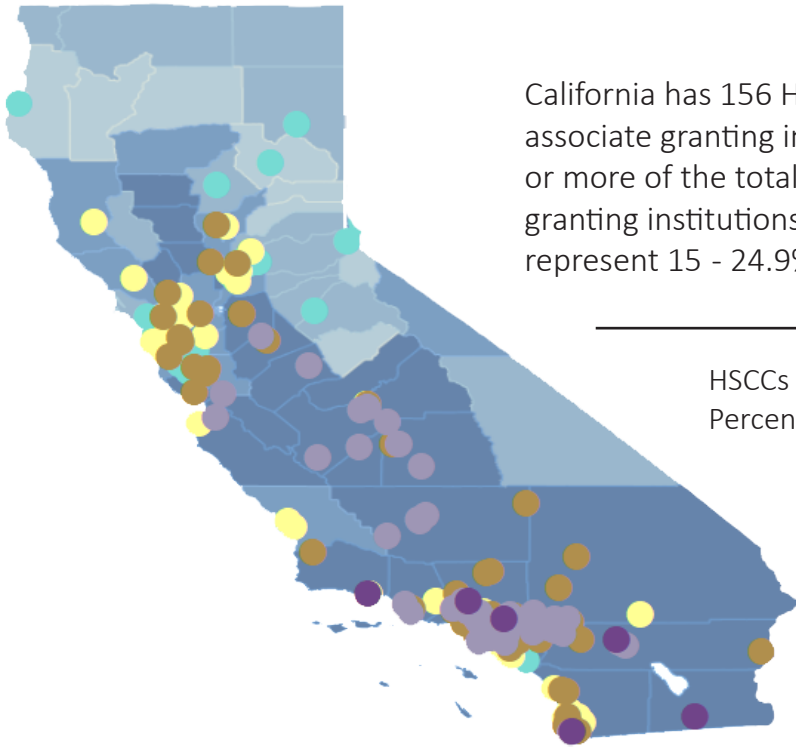


# HISPANIC-SERVING COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN CALIFORNIA



California has 156 Hispanic-Serving Community Colleges. These are associate granting institutions where Latinx students represent 25% or more of the total student population. An additional 33 associate granting institutions are emerging HSCCs, where Latinx students represent 15 - 24.9% of the student population.

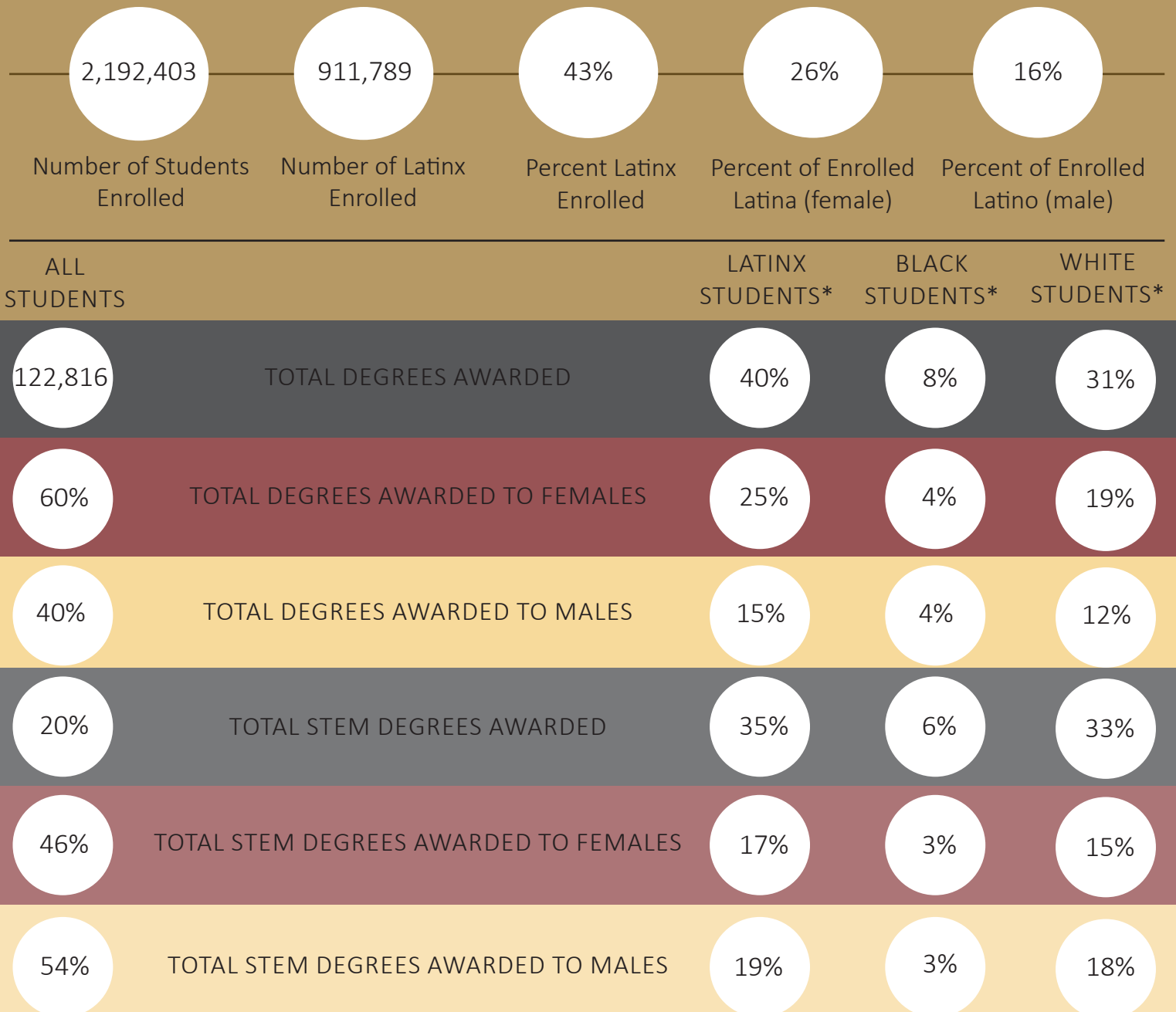
HSCCs and Emerging HSCCs by Percent Latinx Enrolled (2015)
