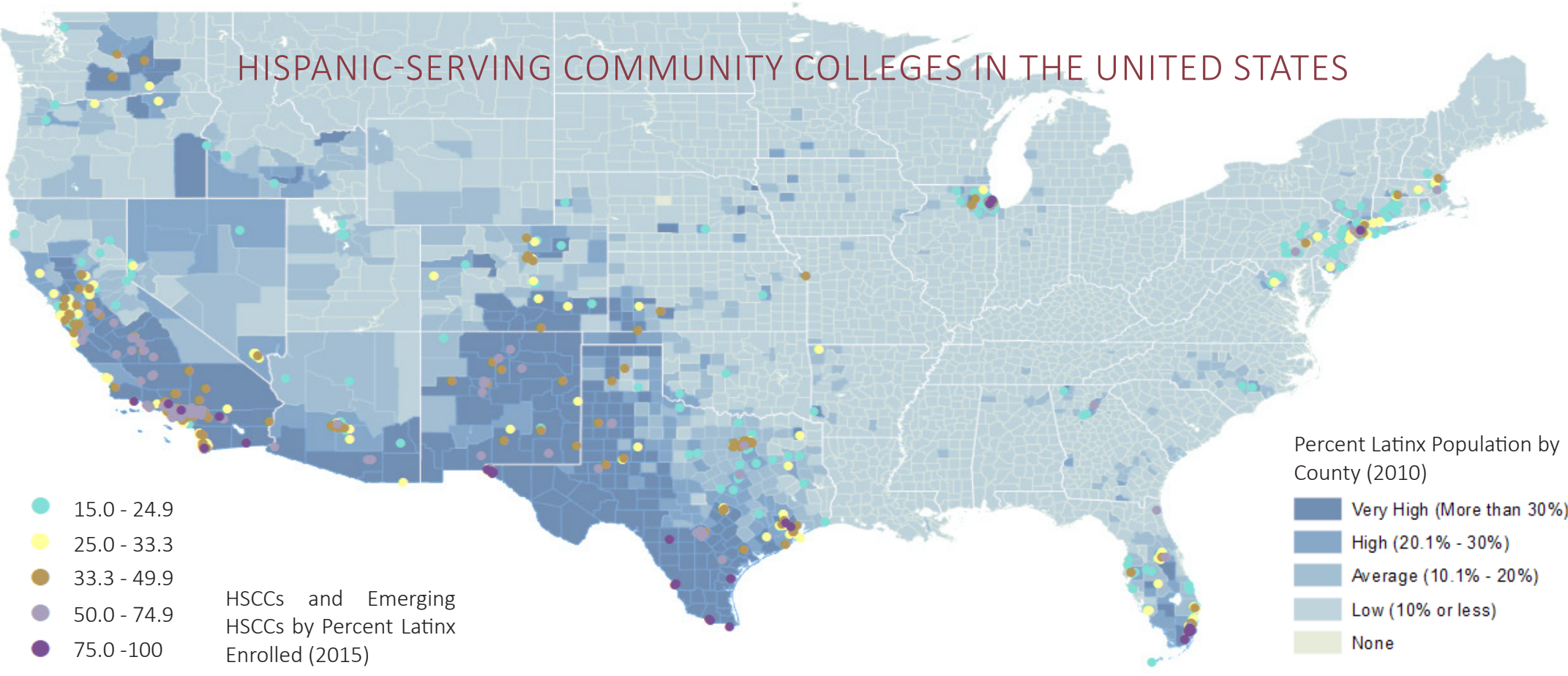
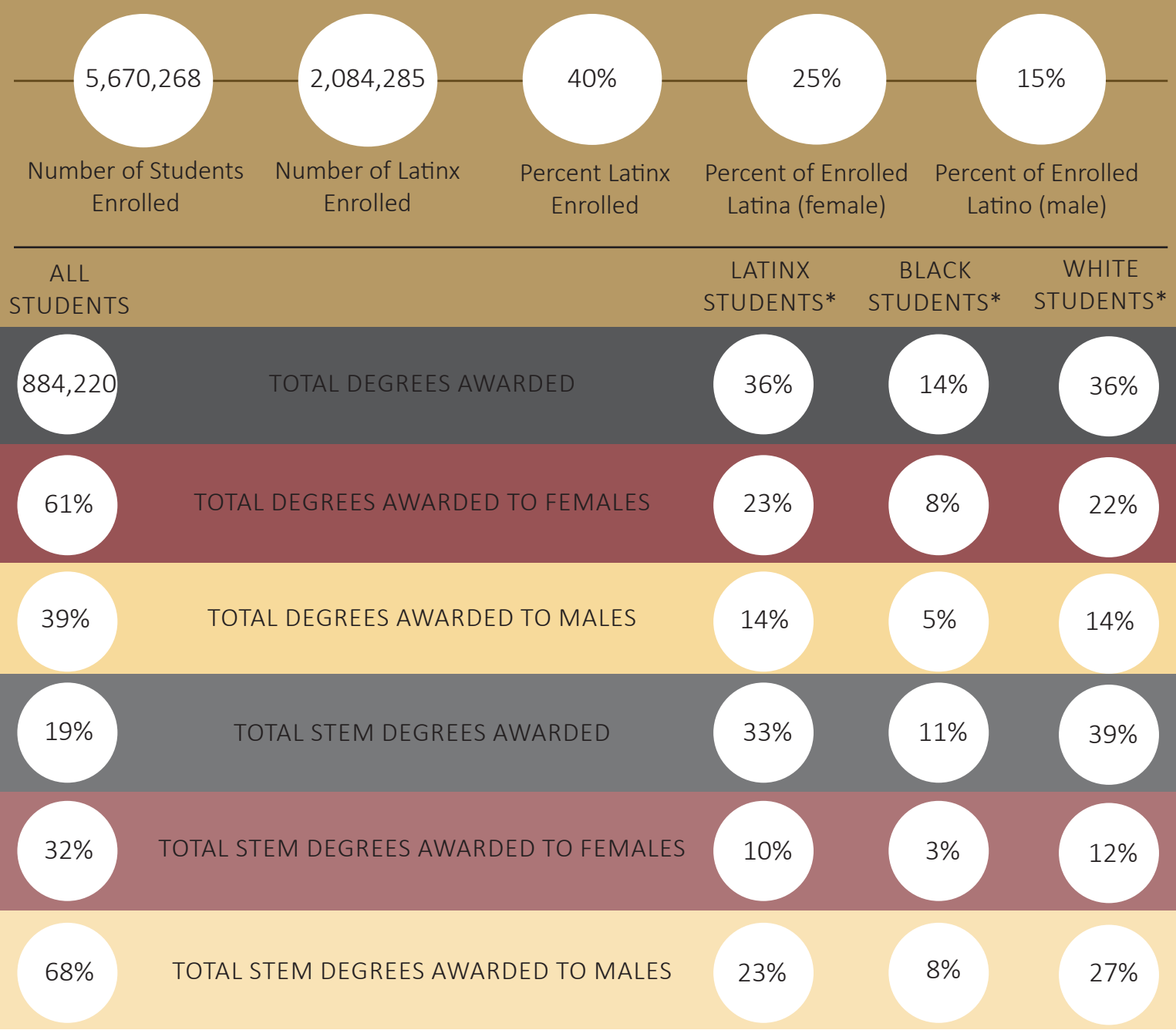


HISPANIC-SERVING COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN THE UNITED STATES



HSCC AND EMERGING HSCC DEMOGRAPHICS IN THE UNITED STATES



There are 449 Hispanic-Serving Community Colleges across the United States. These are associate granting institutions where Latinx students represent 25% or more of the total student population.

The largest numbers of HSCCs institutions can be found in:

- California: 156
- Florida: 43
- Arizona: 24
- Puerto Rico: 23
- New Mexico: 21
- Colorado: 14
- Illinois: 14

An additional 217 associate granting institutions are emerging HSCCs, where Latinx students represent 15 - 24.9% of the student population.
